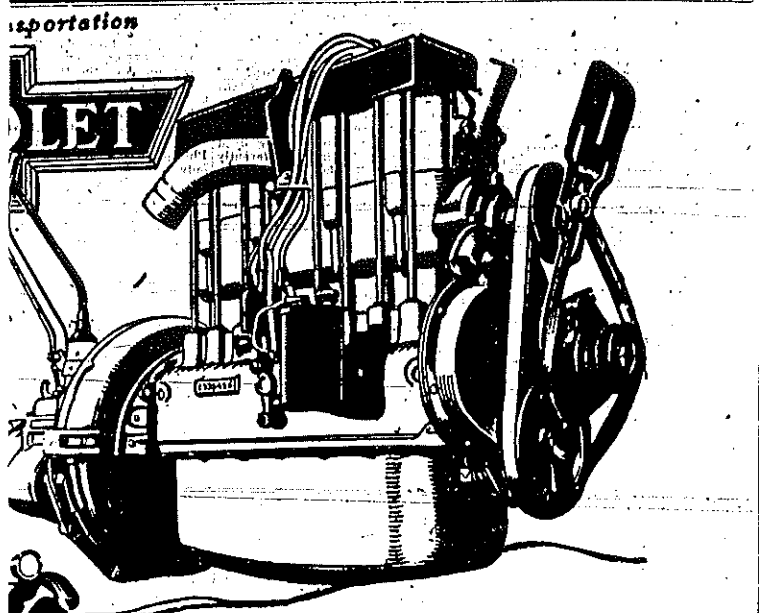
STILL A HOME
Burning of Residence at Milwaukee in Which Still is Said to Have Been Operated Brings Up Question of Payment by Insurance Company For Loss.
 Milwaukee, Wis., Nov. 20. (AP)—A home with a still still a home? This was presented to a jury in Circuit Judge Gustav Gitt's court by

\$1,181 for damages to his home here by a fire. The company has refused to pay on the ground that Pasquale was operating a still. His policy was issued at Dwelling house rates, the company contends, whereas the operating of a still made it a manufacturing plant, and such subject to factory rates. Vaughn and Potty started a drive down the field that carried them over the goal line, Vaughn doing the job over center with little or no trouble. Potty kicked goal from placement. The balance of the quarter the two teams battled up and down the field with the Bull Dogs having a slight advantage over Quitman in yardage gained. Milton hit Tillman for a twenty three yard loss on a punt formation just as the half ended. Thomasville kicked to Quitman in the second half and soon took the ball away from them. They started an irrefutable march down the field with Potty and Harris doing the ball carrying with Patterson occasionally skirting an end for short gains. On the Quitman eight yard line the Brooks Couglins hold for three downs and after a conference the two teams lined up with fourth down and seven yards to go. On a double pass from Mauldin to Harris, Harris ran around left end for a touchdown not a man tackled him but if he had not been as fleet of foot he never would have made it, for the left three Quitman tacklers flat footed in their race for the goal. Potty again kicked goal from placement. In the third quarter Coach Harper sent in almost entirely new team, leaving only four of his regulars on the field. This team held Quitman and threatened to score on them but the game ended before they could complete their threat. "As a whole the feature of the game was the way Mauldin returned punts. It must be admitted that the Quitman ends were rather slow in getting down but they caught them on a dead run and side stepped many tacklers before he was finally downed by one of them.
