

BULLDOGS DEFEAT VALDOSTA, 13-0

ALBANY BRAVES ROLL OVER MOULTRIE PACKERS FOR 18-0 VICTORY

Thomasville Bulldogs Score Amazing Upset Victory Over Wildcats In Annual Classic

Charlie Leitchas Directs Sensational Aerial Attack As the Thomasville Bulldogs Spring Major Upset Before Three Thousand Astonished Fans at Valdosta.

HARPER MEN TURN IN FINE PERFORMANCE

Gridiron History Made As Bulldogs Defeat Valdosta In Annual Armistice Day Battle For First Time Since 1928—Score In Second and Fourth Periods.

Valdosta, Ga., Nov. 12.—A red tornado from Thomasville blew into Cleveland Field here Monday and struck with speed and power and despatch to overthrow Valdosta's high-spirited Wildcats, 13-0, thereby scoring one of the most startling and sensational upsets in the history of youth Georgia football.

The crimson whirlwind composed of eleven flurrying spirited young Thomasville High Bulldogs, took Valdosta's Wildcats and a colorful holiday throng, at some three thousand fans completely by surprise with the viciousness of its drive, stopping everything in its path, had in offer and then sweeping through the cold November air for a touchdown, one in the second quarter and another in the fourth and final period.

Knowtham Aerial Drive

Once again the Thomasville Bulldogs rode to victory on the wing of a sensational aerial attack as they upset their heavier and potentially more powerful foes. It was a drive of resourcefulness and artfulness directed by Charlie Leitchas, the lightning quarterback south Georgia football has seen since the days of Hugh Brown, Albany's great ace of 1928.

The triumph placed the Bulldogs at the top of the heap in the race for gridiron honors in this sector. They remain the only unbeaten and untied eleven in the southern part of the Southwest's Empire State, a team which has convincingly demonstrated its superiority over the Wildcats who were regarded prior to Monday's game as perhaps the strongest grid' force in these parts.

The Bulldogs were the better football team Monday. They outmanned, outmated and outplayed the somewhat overconfident Wildcats in the annual Armistice Day classic which has come to be regarded as the outstanding game of each year in south Georgia high school circles.

The triumph was the first the Bulldogs have scored over Valdosta since the ancient and colorful grid' days when they won, 6-0, here in 1928. It was the fifth Thomasville victory since the ancient and colorful grid' days began a score of years ago. The courageous little gridiron of Coach J. C. Harper made gridiron history today for their victory was the first ever scored over Valdosta by more than a one touchdown margin.

Great Defensive Game

The Bulldogs, overwhelmed by twenty pounds to the man, took everything the big orange and black felines had to offer in the way of an offensive drive and turned it back. The Wildcats threatened only once during the entire game and that was in the second period before either team had scored. The Cats penetrated to Thomasville's 10 yard line on a maddening, the Valdostans recovering a fumble at that point, but those Thomasville youngsters rose up stiffly and threw them back, going on to their victory march.

The Thomasville passing attack was one of the most devastating drives of its kind that has ever been seen in these parts. The Bulldogs outgained Valdosta by a margin of fourteen first downs to seven for the Cats, and a total yardage of 188 yards to 135 for the Wildcats.

It was nearly all Thomasville Monday and your correspondent cannot help going into ecstasy over their performance. They battled in a manner that stamped them as a lot of football playing young men, who have as much fire and spirit and courage as any Thomasville player in history.

Harper has such a display of fortitude and resourcefulness been displayed on any gridiron.

In the third period the Bulldogs were forced to play without their captain, Roy Huber, who was put out of the game by a knee sprain suffered on Saturday.

PLAY BY PLAY DETAIL OF BULLDOGS' ASTOUNDING VICTORY OVER VALDOSTA

Valdosta apparently was football conscious in a big way shortly before game time as a colorful throng of some three thousand fans poured into Cleveland Field. The afternoons were bright and clear and crisp and very cool.

Hundreds of Thomasville fans made their appearance as both teams came on the field to warm up and later retired for last minute instructions from the coaches.

The Valdosta drum and bugle corps marched, the band, the crimson players a martial tune. They wore white and black armbands. The Thomasville and Valdosta cheerleaders, all pretty young maidens, swayed into action behind the precision. Judge W. P. Thomas walked along edge of the band, shaking hands.

Eddie Zant, Wildcat quarterback, was on the field as one of the others while "Pardner" Birch, Thomasville star of the same year, was carrying one end of the chain.

Silke Horowitz, former Valdosta High school and his brother, John, Calico High school, came on the field with the officials.

The Bulldogs trotted out, coach closely followed by the Cats. Coach Harper watched them closely.

He was waiting his feet hot and a little overcast. Hobby Hooks, the present Bulldog master, was about his business.

The Cats looked home beside the Bulldogs as they lined up for the kick-off after Valdosta. Roy Harmer, of Thomasville was the toss and cleared to offend the east goal with the ball in his hand but a wind at his back. Captain Niles, phone to referee, called off tackle on a various series of fakes and reverses.

Taking the ball at midfield with Clary, a small Wildcat halfback, Murph and Pearce recovered for Thomasville, the Bulldogs marched straight to the promised line in an unbroken sweep.

They slacked right out through the air from midfield, Leitchas passing to Pearce for a gain of six yards. Pearce was then thrown for a 2 yard loss by Niles at left tackle but on the next play Leitchas slipped a short pass to Fair for a first down at the 20 yard stripe.

The Cats crossed the goal line at the 10 yard stripe. Leitchas tossed another to Pearce and it was good for two yards. He passed again to Hinsdale for a first down at the 10 yard line. That was three passes but another one was incomplete when Gormin got it, and he Charlie sent Pearce scampering at left tackle and the little speedster bolted 10 yards to the 10 yard line. That was crossing the Cats up. Another pass was complete but for no gain, and Pearce strolled through for three yards and a first down at the 10 yard line.
