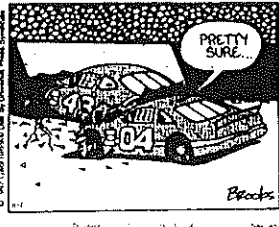

ALBANY — In a classic GISA Region 3-AAA battle, the Brookwood Warriors lost 35-28 to Sherwood Christian Friday night. Brookwood came out showcasing its balanced attack as the running game, led by Wesley Brown, opened up early, and the passing game excelled as well, led by quarterback Jason Hurst. After Hurst connected on a pass with Mark Haney, Brown scored on a 1-yard run to give Brookwood a 6-0 lead. Sherwood then took advantage of a Brookwood turnover when Ben Drawdy scored to give Sherwood the lead, Drawdy added two more touchdowns to give Sherwood a 22-6 lead. Brookwood then switched things around after a Sherwood turnover, as Hurst scored on a short run to make the score 22-12.
